Your course is subject to FAA review. If the reviewing FAA Aviation Safety Inspector determines that your course does not meet the guidelines, you will receive notification.

Your FAA-accepted course number, **C-IND-IM-091230-K-006-001**, will expire **August 31, 2013**.
